 Introduction
 In 1983, during the first meeting: Health Informatics in Developing Countries: experiences and viewpoints, held in Mexico and organized by A. Fernandez Peres de Talens, E. Molino and D. Shires, the main reasons for developing countries to become involved with health informatics were:

- informatics technology after the initial investment in basic equipment and personnel formation, should be sustained by an investment of local manpower, unlike the importation of other technologies;
- being a critical time for developing countries because multinational informatics cooperations are rapidly developing software packages and it is crucial for developing countries to be aware of this and react quickly or be left with the only alternative of importing turnkey systems, possibly inappropriate to their needs;

IMIA WG 9 has 37 members from 19 countries and the main goals for the group are:

- to maintain a database "Who is Who" in Third World Medical Informatics;
- to prioritize the informatization and automation of Primary Health Care and Health Care Management;
- to create an official medical informatics network in order to assure data standardization to allow its interchange, quality and equipment compatibility, including basic hardware and software tools to selected focal points, as well as training, distribution of educational software and teaching know-how to medical students.
